Applications will be reviewed and judged on the basis of financial need, academic record, community and extracurricular activities and future goals.

Who can apply?

Any male high school senior who has applied and been accepted into a four-year college or university that is recognized by the major accrediting organizations for U.S. colleges, universities, and higher education schools. **The person(s) applying are required to currently live within a 50-mile radius of St. Louis Missouri.**

What can students do with the money?

Students can use their scholarship money on any school related activity they choose as they continue to pursue their goals and/or dreams. Examples include tuition, housing, books, supplies, and activity fees.

What is required of an applicant?

Students applying for a Scholarship must:

- Complete and submit an application form,
- Provide a copy of official high school transcript
- Provide three letters of recommendations,
- Provide a copy of an essay that was submitted with one of your college applications
- Provide a letter of acceptance from a college or university
- Formal Interview with the Kappa Sigma Chapter Education Committee
